2. Point Standings :

Top 10 positions qualify for the finals. Enclosed is a copy of the current standings as of the last qualifying event. Full standings can be found on this website at www.ipracanada.com.

Important Note: If one or more persons cannot compete among the top 10 in any event, the 11th person will become eligible to compete, and so on. If there is a tie for 10th and 11th position, both contestants will be eligible. Positions will be filled based on standings and availability for those who sent the entries form between April 1st & 7th, 2019. Must had participate minimum 3 rodeos during season 2018.

Information: In order to ensure your spot in the Finals, all contestants that have interest in being a part of the Finals must send the entries form to make their entries. If any contestants in top 10 cannot compete, the next position will be qualified

4. Camping spot and stalls :

You can also keep your horse on your camping spot, a 20\$ fees will also be charge for the weekend and 50\$ deposit for cleaning.

5. Contestant Awards:

All awards will be given after the last performance on Sunday at the rodeo secretary office. There will be buckles for the SEASON champion and the FINALS champion, there will also be a buckle for the all-around cowboy. Participants/Finalists who submitted their entries forms between April 1st & 7th, 2019, will also receive a coat as a finalist.

6. Rules and Guidelines

You must have paid or pay your IPRA Canada 2019 Card or IPRA Card to participate in the IPRA Final in St-Tite. The cost of the IPRA Canada card is 195\$. If you buy your card at the rodeo secretary at the same time as you pay for your entries, 25\$ will be added to your membership.

Following the conclusion of the finals, if there is a tie for the first place Finals Champion in any event, the individual winning the most points in that event during the regular 2018 Canadian IPRA Tour will be declared the winner. The prize money will be divided as per regular payout procedure however the prizes will be distributed equally to both competitors.
